### **Gray returns to Aspire Indiana in new role: Director of Training, Clinical Supervision and Outcomes**

Noblesville, Ind. (August, 2011) – Dr. Michael Gray has been named Director of Training, Clinical Supervision and Outcomes for Aspire Indiana. Gray earned a bachelor degree in psychology from Bowling Green State University and a Ph.D. in clinical psychology from Miami University in Oxford, OH. His training encompassed work at Dunn Center, CMHC Inc., Miami University Center for School-based Mental Health Programs, Butler University Counseling and Consultation Services at Aspire Indiana’s legacy site, BehaviorCorp.

In his new role, Gray will provide oversight on the implementation of evidence-based/recovery and resiliency-oriented practices, recommendations and training on emerging clinical practices, and improvement analysis on mental health service outcomes. He will also work in conjunction with other doctors in supervising interns from the Butler Consortium Pre-doctoral Psychology Internship Program. Additional responsibilities include enhancing rater reliability in the scoring of both the Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) and Adult Needs and Strengths (ANSA) assessment tools agency-wide and providing training on various mental health practices.

Aspire Indiana is a private nonprofit organization that provides therapy, recovery and employment services to people living with behavioral and mental health disorders, addictions and substance abuse.
