The position will oversee two programs under the umbrella of Vocational Services, Career Connections and Indiana Works. Career Connections assists adults with disabilities in finding and maintaining employment through funding such as Vocational Rehabilitation or the Ticket to Work program. Indiana Works, also known as “WIPA” (Work Incentives Planning and Assistance) assist Social Security beneficiaries with free benefits counseling who are currently employed, re-entering the work force or are interested in work.

Aspire Indiana is a private nonprofit organization that provides therapy and recovery services to people living with behavioral and mental health disorders, addictions and substance abuse.
